Workforce Advisory Committee Charter



Purpose

- Provide recommendations to the Early Childhood Policy Council and other entities on all aspects of early childhood education on an ongoing basis.

Workforce Advisory Committee Charter



Membership

- Appointed by the Governor, Legislature, and Superintendent
- Comprised of a diverse set of providers:
 - licensed family childcare providers
 - family, friend, and neighbor childcare providers
 - center-based teachers and directors from subsidized and nonsubsidized childcare programs
 - statewide organizations representing childcare providers
- Two members will be appointed by the committee to serve on the Early Childhood Policy Council (to serve a term of 3 years and no more than two terms (6 years total))

Workforce Advisory Committee Charter



Operating Principles

- Attend meetings
- Share your expertise
- Listen to other points of view and try to understand their interests
- Share information openly, promptly, and respectfully
- Remain flexible and open-minded, actively participate in meetings
