I am writing to urge to endorse and fight for a single payer Medicare system for California. I am a voting resident of California, for my entire life. I grew up here, I received a public education here from kindergarten through the University of California system, and I currently work in the legalized cannabis industry.

As I work in the cannabis industry, and it has been impossible for the company I work for to offer us insurance due to the banking issues regarding cannabis and federal regulations.
